Parents will be asked to return at 10.45 or 14.30 with a plate of food so you can join us in our celebration.

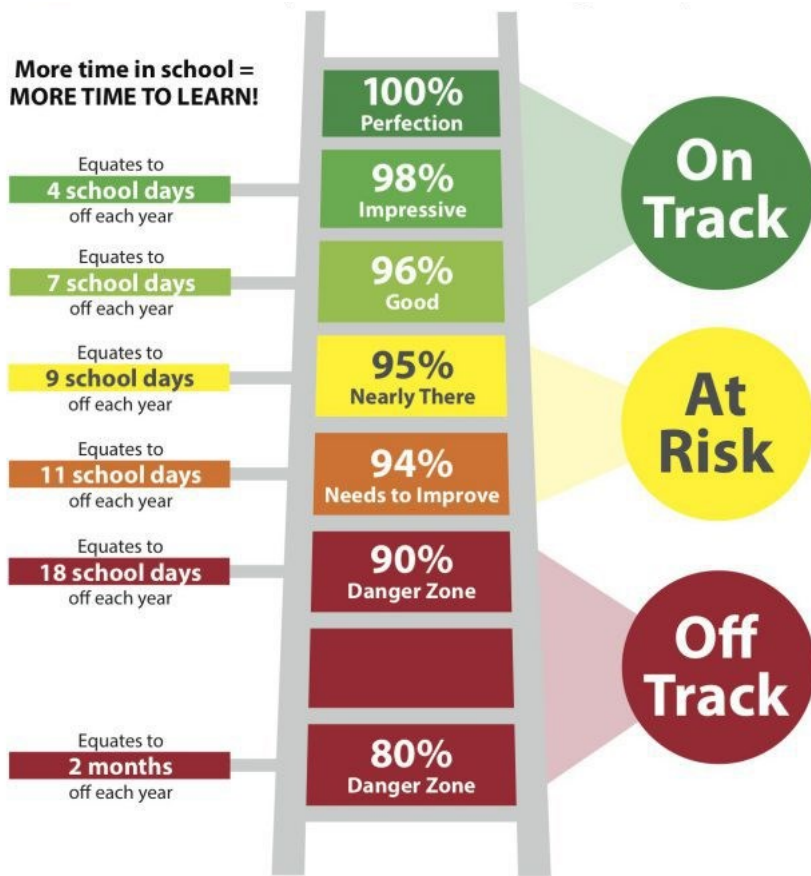
Christmas Sing-a-long
