### Staffing

Welcome back to Amanda who is returning after her maternity leave. She will be working in Meadow and Orchard for this term.

### Parking

We cannot stress strongly enough the **dangers** of the cars parking on the pavements. If you are using Arnside Close for dropping off please **do not mount the pavement**. Our children are walking on the pavement and you are putting them in danger. **Keep our children safe as they come to school**. The police were visiting after a call and were shocked that they were blocked in with blue lights flashing. Ideally you should be parking legally, not on double yellow lines when bringing your child to nursery school.

We have also had complaints from staff and our neighbours when the gates and driveways are obstructed. Please be respectful of the public.

### Transition Day 4th July

On the 4th July it is transition day across the city. We apologise if your child's school has alternative dates but if your child is going to school next year they are not expected at Hillfields Nursery School. This does not affect their attendance. We are using this day to ensure our children who will return in September can get to know their new spaces.

### Eid

If your family is celebrating Eid on 15th June please can you complete a holiday form. They will be in the areas and at Reception this week.

### Clothing

With the warmer weather, hopefully staying, please ensure that your child has spare clothes in their bag. This will enable the children to change when they get wet due to water play.

It is important that the children wear sun cream when the sun is out. It does not have to be hot for the rays to be dangerous to their skin.
